SUMMER PACKETS During the last week of school, the children received their summer packets. This is voluntary work, but we encourage you to have your children complete it. It will make a difference in the progress of your children when they return to school in September.

Reading is always a worthwhile activity to keep the girls' skills up to par and helps build their vocabulary. It is equally worthwhile for 1st graders to spend time on their math work and practice their number facts. In addition to *davening* daily, the children always benefit from a few minutes of Hebrew reading, *kriah* practice. We strongly encourage you to make this a project at home. Reading Tehillim, with periodic incentives, has proven as an effective way to make this a goal oriented, enjoyable activity. *Kriah* remains the foundation for all other *limudei kodesh* skills and will stand your daughter in a strong position for second grade.

With tremendous appreciation to Rabbi Ariel Sadwin, there will be MTA bus service for the coming school year. Please note that while we work to secure a faculty monitor for the bus, at this time, we have not found someone to assume this role. Assuming we will find such a person, each family regularly participating in the MTA service must pay \$100 to cover the cost of this monitor. If a family sends more than one child on the bus, the fee is \$125. This fee is paid directly to the monitor. Once we find that person, we will inform the parents.

Any student who rides the MTA bus must follow the MTA's Covid regulations. Parents can find further information on the MTA's website.

Please note that all parents relying on the MTA must have a backup plan if the bus does not arrive. Any day the bus is not on campus by 3:35, a text will go out for parents to pick up their children.




