Haschalas Navi

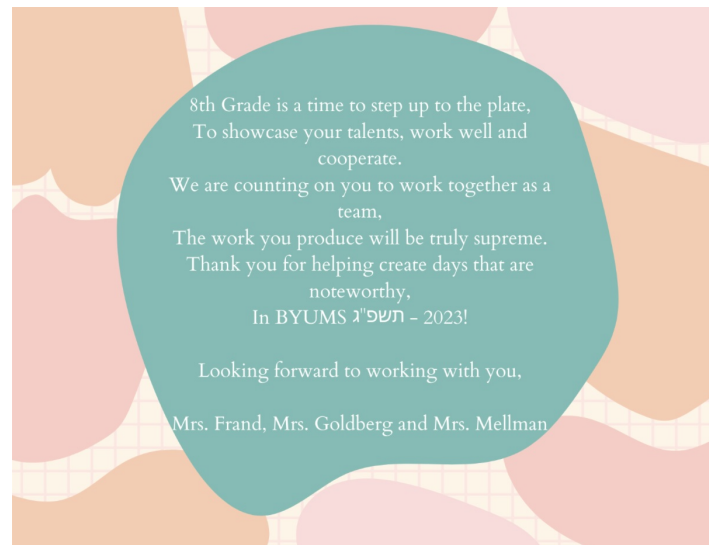

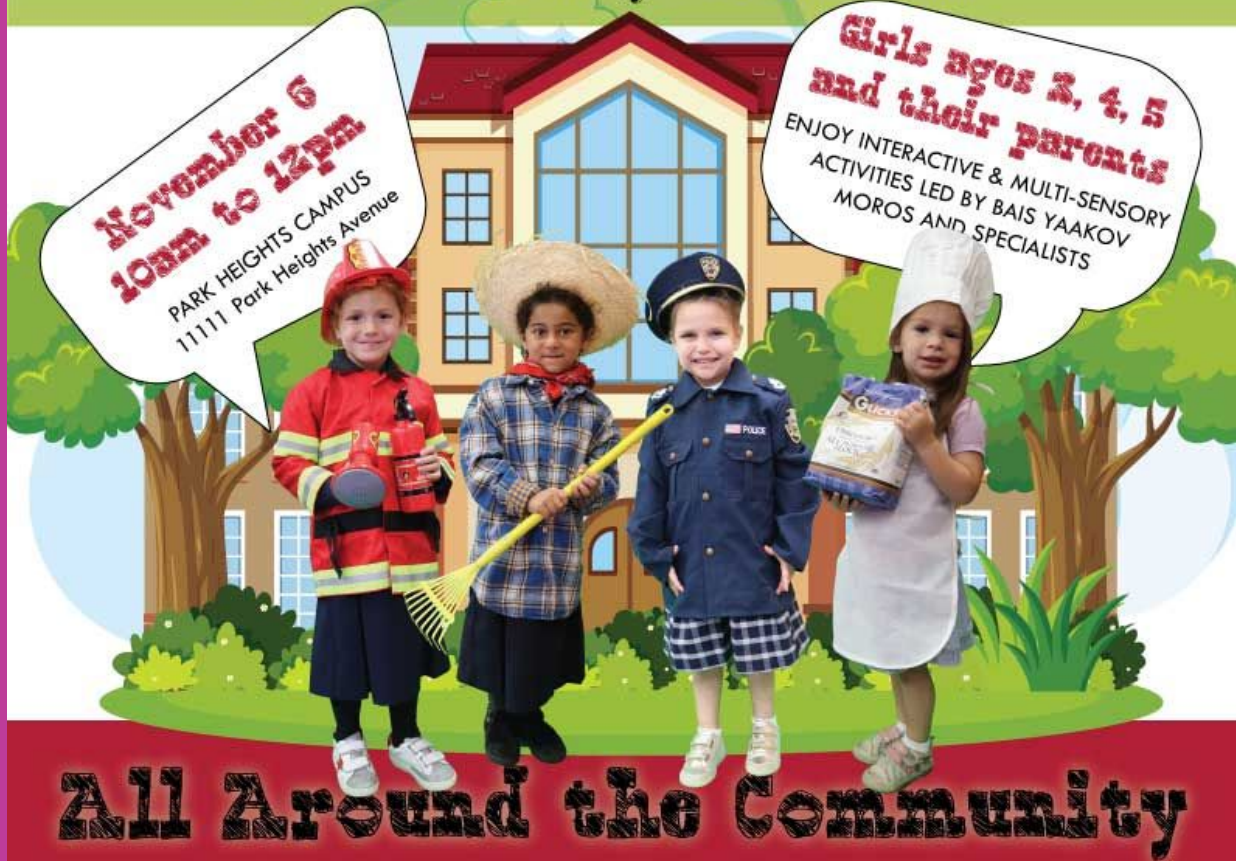
