Dr. Yoel Jakobovits, renowned physician, *Talmid Chacham*, and **Chair of the** *Bais Yaakov Vaad Hachinuch*, presented his annual talk on "*Torah* and Science" to the **Tenth Grade**, in conjunction with their study of *Parashas Bereishis*. The presentation and question and answer segment that followed underscored how our *emunah* has withstood the test of time and is not in any manner weakened or intellectually challenged by findings or theories in the scientific community. Beyond the specific details discussed, the meeting demonstrated the supreme confidence of our *Talmidei Chachamim* and educated professionals in the timeless Truths of the *Torah*.



The scheduled meeting with **Rabbi Daniel Mechanic** and the **Eleventh Grade** reinforces this grade's understanding of the *yesodos* (foundations) of *Yahadus* in contrast to the misdirected beliefs of other peoples.






High School Staff on the Go


