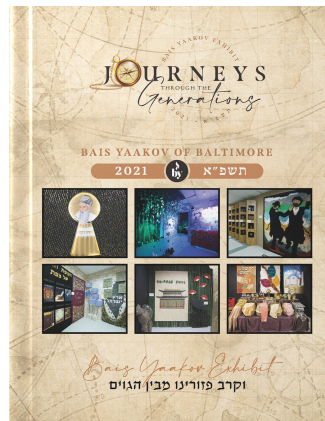
### Many Siyumim!
