Living Pirkei Avos

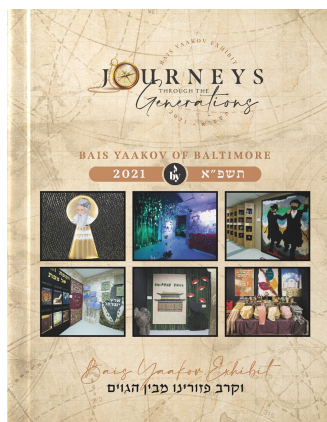

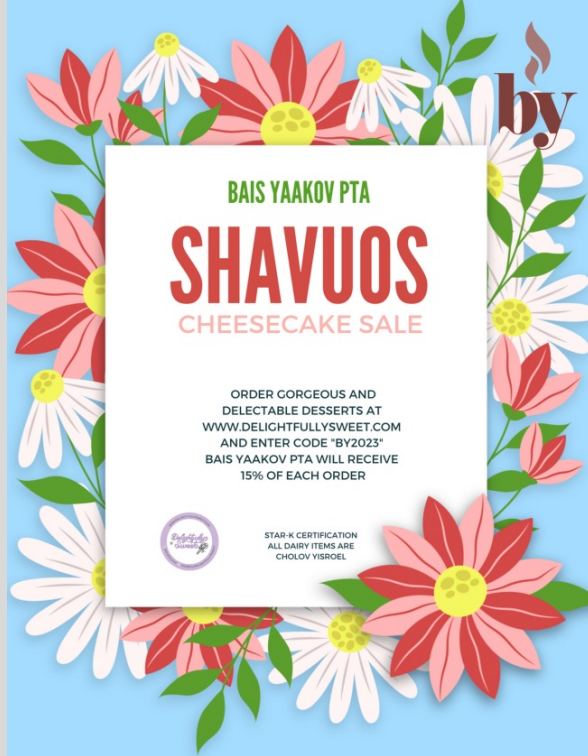
Eighth Grade Trip
