### Preschool Graduations

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### Developing Promising Young Readers

We were excited to conclude this year's **Second Grade** reading program with our "**Read Your Way to a Cookie Party!**" The girls enjoyed a Zoom presentation by **Mrs. Bracha Goetz**, a noted local children's author, who encouraged our students to think and capture ideas in writing. The girls had fun decorating cookies with colored food paint.

Our bulletin board was filled with over 700 paper cookies, one for each book read over the past few months. On average, each student read five books! Our reading program fostered increased fluency, accuracy, and improved comprehension skills.



### Promoting Derech Eretz

Each student in **First** and **Second Grade** learned 18 *ma'amarim* and songs from *Pirkei Avos*, which promotes awareness of *derech eretz* and *middos tovos*. Each student created a special cup to celebrate this accomplishment.



### End-of-Year In Upper Elementary

The **Upper Elementary** enjoyed many celebrations over the last few weeks of school including a *Pirkei Avos* Chinese Auction in the **Third Grade**. The girls also enjoyed a

wonderful *Kriah* Candy Cart, which came around to each class, allowing them to spend their *Kriah* cash on fun prizes. Additionally, they had a chance to use their *Parsha* dollars at the final *Parsha* store. The **Fourth Grade** enjoyed an end-of-year book club celebration. The girls performed "**Heading West**," a play based on the story





of Little House on the Prairie, and presented many interesting facts about life in America during the 1800's. They also enjoyed a pool party, *Pirkei Avos* Auction, and finished their *Kriah* Canteen spending.



#### **Fourth Grade Siyum and Celebration**

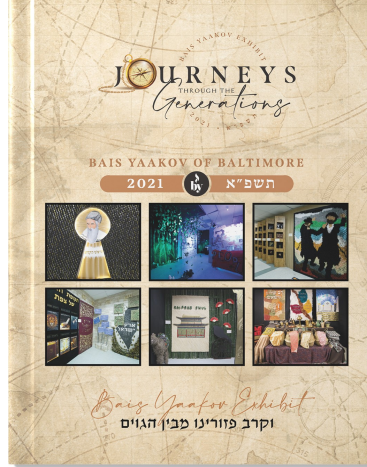
