THINKING OF ACHEINU B'NEI YISROEL

In light of the war in *Eretz Yisroel*, **Rabbi Duvi Rubin**, *Rav of Khal Ohr Yisrael*, spoke to each grade about utilizing our **Three T's** in a positive way: **Thoughts** (empathy, *tefillah*), **Talk** (positive speech with others), and **Tasks** (*maasim tovim*). Names of soldiers have been distributed to each student to keep in mind for extra *tefillos*. Our *Ivrit* classes will be writing letters of strength to young children in *Eretz Yisroel*. Lastly, our **Seventh and Eighth Grades** have chosen personalized, small, positive *kabbalos* (actions) to maintain throughout the next month.





BIRCHAS HASHACHAR

Beginning in **Seventh Grade**, girls are expected to *daven Birchos HaShachar* (morning blessings) before arriving in school each morning. In order to reinforce and help the girls connect to this wonderful mitzvah, an explanatory version of the *brachos* was distributed along with a check-list for students to monitor themselves during *Aseres Yemei Teshuva*. Students who consistently *davened brachos* before eating breakfast, were treated to muffins in school.

BORUCH HASHEM FOR SHABBOS

The Middle School is working on strengthening our Shabbos observance on behalf of our brothers and sisters in Eretz Yisroel. The Sixth Grade has kicked off their BHFS (Baruch Hashem for Shabbos) program in coordination with the learning of the Lamed Tes Melachos. Rabbi Tzvi Mordechai Feldheim, Rosh Mesivta of Yeshivas Kesser Torah, addressed the girls and discussed how Shabbos is the source of all bracha and how fortunate we are to enjoy this special treasure each week.
