

UPPER ELEMENTARY UNIFORM GUIDELINES

Skirt

- The Bais Yaakov Middle School pleated skirt, or the Bais Yaakov Elementary plaid or navy skirt.
- The skirt must easily cover the student's knees at all times, whether sitting, standing, or walking.
- A student's skirt must be long enough, and her knee socks must be high enough so that no skin is visible between the skirt and socks. This description is observable, simple, and clear for parents, students, and teachers alike.

Shirt

- Light blue $\frac{3}{4}$ sleeve oxford with BY logo.
- Navy and light blue pique long-sleeved polo shirt with BY logo.
- Rosh Chodesh / Special Event White Shirt - See Letter about this.

Sweatshirt

- Only Bais Yaakov sweatshirts with the BY logo may be worn. These sweatshirts are available throughout the year through the PTA and from Lands' End.
- Please label your daughter's sweatshirt.

Hosiery

- Knee socks or tights must be worn. They may be purchased from any vendor.
- If a student's socks are not meeting her skirt (see above), she will be asked to change into a pair of knee socks available in the office, for which we will charge the parent \$3 per pair.
- Leggings may not be worn.

Shoes

- All shoes must have backs and be proper shoes. (No clogs, Crocs, Natives, Floafers, etc.)
- Sneakers are required for all physical education classes. Rubber-soled shoes are not allowed as these shoes often do not have proper support for the type of movement in the gym and on the field.

Nail Polish

- Nail polish is not permitted. This includes clear and light shades.
- Students will be sent to the office to remove nailpolish, if it is worn.

Students must be in their uniforms on all school days and at any Bais Yaakov activity outside of school hours. (Examples: Class Chanuka party or S.T.E.M. EXPO)

Each year, we look for ways to increase Kedusha and a Torah atmosphere in our school in a manner that is especially meaningful for our students. Whenever we have two days of Rosh Chodesh, we will designate the first day as the day to wear it.

Q. What if it is not available on the day of Rosh Chodesh?

We are excited to enhance Rosh Chodesh in this way and hope that whoever is able will encourage their daughters to join us. Of course, no one will be penalized if they are unable to wear it for any reason.
